On February 24, 2016, Mark Crosby, President/CEO of the Enterprise Wireless Alliance ("EWA"), Morgan O'Brien, Vice-Chairman of pdvWireless, Inc. (previously Pacific DataVision, Inc.) ("PDV"), Lance Johnson of PDV, and undersigned counsel met with the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("WTB") staff listed below. With the exception of Mr. Noel and Mr. Spann who participated via telephone, the other individuals attended the meeting in person. The FCC staff advised that the WTB continues its process of reviewing the issues raised in the EWA/PDV Petition for Rulemaking ("Petition") in the above-identified proceeding and needs no additional information from EWA or PDV at this time. EWA/PDV advised the staff that they were engaged in ongoing discussions with incumbents both in the 900 MHz band and in adjacent bands and were addressing issues raised by those incumbents in filings responsive to the Petition. PDV also explained that it had entered into certain 900 MHz spectrum swaps to relocate narrowband systems to the lower part of the 900 MHz band and into agreements to acquire additional 900 MHz spectrum.
