On March 5, 2019, Chris Guttman-McCabe of CGM Advisors, consultant to pdvWireless, Inc. ("PDV"), had separate telephone conversations with Umair Javed, Legal Advisor, Wireless and International to Commissioner Rosenworcel, and William Davenport, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Starks. On March 6, Mr. Guttman-McCabe had separate conversations with Rachael Bender, Wireless and International Advisor to Chairman Pai, and Will Adams, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Carr.
